**The Wellingborough (Related Alterations) (Amendment) Order
2010**

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Electoral Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1A) of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997^(a) (“the 1997 Act”), make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Wellingborough (Related Alterations) (Amendment) Order 2010.

(2) This Order comes into force on the day after that which it is made.

Amendment to the Wellingborough (Related Alterations) Order 2009

2. The Schedule to the Wellingborough (Related Alterations) Order 2009^(b) is amended as follows—

- (a) In Table 1, in the first row of column 1, delete the word “Queensway” and insert the word “Finedon”.
- (b) In Table 2, in the first row of column 1, delete the word “Queensway” and insert the words “Great Doddington and Wilby”.
- (c) In Table 2 omit the second row of each column.
