ROAD TRAFFIC

The M5 Motorway (Junctions 17-18) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009 Variation Order 2010

Made - - - - - *23 February 2010*

Coming into force - - - - - *25 February 2010*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junctions 17-18) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009 Variation Order 2010 and shall come into force on 25 February 2010.

2. The M5 Motorway (Junctions 17-18) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009(b) is hereby varied by substituting, for the definition “a second works period” in article 2, the following definition:

‘ “a second works period” means a period of 16 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Saturday 27 February 2010 and then at the same times on subsequent Saturdays until the said works have been completed;’
