**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M602 Motorway (Westbound Link Road to the M60 Motorway Clockwise at Junction 12) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - 23 February 2010

*Coming into force* - - 28 February 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M602 and M60 Motorways and link roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the City of Salford in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 **(a)** and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M602 Motorway (Westbound Link Road to the M60 Motorway Clockwise at Junction 12) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 28 February 2010.

2. In this Order;

“the link road” means the link road leading from the westbound carriageway of the M602 Motorway at Junction 1 to the clockwise carriageway of the M60 Motorway at Junction 12;

“works” means cyclical maintenance works on the link road;

“the works period” means periods over two nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 1 March 2010 and ending on Friday 28 May 2010. However works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights, or continue until completed.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
