**The M25 Motorway and the M3 Motorway (M25 Junctions 11
and 12, Slip/Link Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2010**

Made - - - - *1st March 2010*
Coming into force - - *6th March 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M25 Motorway, the M3 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M25 Motorway and the M3 Motorway (M25 Junctions 11 and 12, Slip/Link Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 6th March 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the M25” and “the M3” mean, respectively, the M25 Motorway and the M3 Motorway in the County of Surrey;

“the slip road” means the road leading from the anti-clockwise carriageway of the M25 to the A317 (St Peter’s Way) at Junction 11;

“a link road” means any road leading from the westbound carriageway and the eastbound carriageway of the M3 at Junction 2 to the anti-clockwise carriageway of the M25 at Junction 12 (Thorpe Interchange);

“works” mean resurfacing work on the M25 and the M3; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 8th March 2010 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 8 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 12th March 2010 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 9 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 13th March 2010 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 14th March 2010 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 5th September 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road or a link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
