ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M5 Motorway (Junction 28 Slip Roads) (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - *17 February 2010*
Coming into force - - *20 February 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on those connecting roads at Junction 28 in the County of Somerset should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a), 5(b) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and with the consent of Devon County Council in so far as the alternative road is concerned, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 28 Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20 February 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the slip roads” mean the northbound and southbound entry and exit slip roads at M5 Junction 28;

“the works” mean resurfacing works on the A373 junction roundabout and overbridge;

“the alternative road” means the B3181 through Willand between Junctions 27 and 28 in Devon;

“a works period” means a period of 12 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Monday 22 February 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.

5. During a works period, the provisions of The County of Devon (Cullompton to Willand and adjacent roads) (17 Tonnes Weight Limit) Order 1990 are hereby suspended in so far as they relate to the alternative road.
