## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A27 Trunk Road (Pevensey Bypass) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2010

Made - - - - 1st March 2010

Coming into force - - 6th March 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Pevensey Bypass) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 6th March 2010.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A27 Trunk Road northeast of Eastbourne in the County of East Sussex;

"the length of trunk road" means the trunk road between Pevensey roundabout (A259 – Wallsend Road) and a point 1518 metres west of that roundabout;

"works" mean resurfacing and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 8th March 2010 or on any subsequent day until 5th September 2011.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding
  - (a) 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed; or
  - (b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
