ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Markeaton Roundabout to Palm Court Roundabout, Derby) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - 22 February 2010

Coming into force - - 1 March 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads in the City of Derby should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Markeaton Roundabout to Palm Court Roundabout, Derby) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 1 March 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A38 from its roundabout junction with the A52 (Markeaton Roundabout) to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A6 (Palm Court Roundabout);

“a slip road” means the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A38 to –

(i) Kedleston Road; and

(ii) the A6 (Palm Court Roundabout);

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 8 March 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or

(c) being used in connection with the said works.
