## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A52 and A453 Trunk Roads (Nottingham) (Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - 22 February 2010

Coming into force - - 1 March 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road ("the A52"), the A453 Trunk Road ("the A453") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the City of Nottingham should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A52 and A453 Trunk Roads (Nottingham) (Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 1 March 2010.

### **2.** In this Order:

"the link road" means the link road, which forms the flyover over Queens

Drive Roundabout, leading from the westbound carriageway of the A52 Clifton Boulevard to the northbound carriageway of the A453 Queens Drive;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 8

March 2010 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- **5.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or (c) being used in connection with the said works.
