Amendments to Communications Act 2003 and related amendments

Communications Act 2003

- 66. In section 107 (procedure for directions applying the electronic communications code)—
 - (a) after subsection (1) insert—
 - "(1A) Regulation 3 of the Electronic Communications and Wireless Telegraphy Regulations 2011 makes provision about the time within which an application under subsection (1) must be determined.", and
 - (b) after subsection (3) insert—
 - "(3A) A modification may not be made under subsection (3) unless the modification is—
 - (a) objectively justifiable, and
 - (b) proportionate to what it is intended to achieve.
 - (3B) Before making a modification under subsection (3), OFCOM must publish a notification of the proposed modification which contains the following—
 - (a) a statement of the proposal,
 - (b) a statement of their reasons for the proposal, and
 - (c) a statement of the period within which representations may be made to them about the proposal.
 - (3C) The period specified under subsection (3B)(c) must end no less than one month after the day of the publication of the notification."
