 - (b) in Part 2 of Schedule 4 (abolition of contracting-out for defined contribution pension schemes: further amendments)—

 - (ii) paragraph 59(1), in so far as it relates to paragraph 59(2) and (4),

 - (c) Part 7 of Schedule 7 (abolition of contracting-out for defined contribution pension schemes: further repeals) in so far as it relates to the repeal of the specified provisions contained within paragraph 2 of Schedule 4 to the Pension Schemes Act 1993[F2, and section 137(7)(a) of the Pensions Act 1995]M1.
