The M40 Motorway (Junction 8a, Oxfordshire) Northbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M40 Motorway ("the M40") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Oxfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M40 Motorway (Junction 8a, Oxfordshire) Northbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 30th May 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 7 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 6th June 2011 or any subsequent day until works on the adjacent County road have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound exit and entry slip roads leading to and from the A418 at Junction 8a of the M40.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
