The Incidental Flooding and Coastal
Erosion (England) Order 2011

Coming into force - - 1st December 2011

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 38(8) and 39(12) of the Flood and Water Management Act 2010⁽¹⁾ makes the following Order.

A draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament pursuant to sections 38(9)(a) and 39(13)(a) of that Act.
