Appearance of authority in legal proceedings

10. Where a contractor is authorised by virtue of this Order to exercise the function of applying to a magistrates' court for a liability order or taking steps to levy any amount by distress and sale of the goods of any person, section 223 of the Local Government Act 1972⁽¹⁾ (appearance of local authorities in legal proceedings) shall have effect in relation to—

- (a) the hearing of an application for a liability order, and
- (b) an appeal brought by any person in connection with the distress,

as if the contractor were an officer of the authority.
