**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A46 Trunk Road (Bishopton to Marraway, Warwickshire)  
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *4th February 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *11th February 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Bishopton to Marraway, north of Stratford-upon-Avon in the County of Warwickshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Bishopton to Marraway, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 11th February 2011.

2. In this Order –

| “Bishopton Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A3400, Birmingham Road, at Bishopton;           |
| “Marraway Roundabout”  | means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A439 at Marraway;                               |
| “the trunk road”       | means the eastbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with Bishopton Roundabout to its junction with Marraway Roundabout; |
| “the works period”     | means the period starting at 06.00 hours on Sunday 20 February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;          |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 10 miles per hour on lengths of the Bishopton Roundabout and Marraway Roundabout whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed.
- (b) 40 miles per hour on lengths of the Bishopton Roundabout and Marraway Roundabout when such signs are not displayed.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4, shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

**6.** The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- (b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
