**The Immigration (Designation of Travel  
Bans) (Amendment No.2) Order 2011**

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8B(5) of the Immigration Act 1971<sup>(1)</sup>:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment No.2) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 5th March 2011.

**2.** In Part 2 of the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000<sup>(2)</sup>, insert “Council Decision 2011/137/CFSP of 28th February 2011 (Libya).”<sup>(3)</sup> at the appropriate place.
