**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M25 Motorway, the M3 Motorway and the A316 Trunk Road (Thorpe Interchange and Sunbury Cross) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - - *30th April 2012*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *19th May 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M25 Motorway, the M3 Motorway, the A316 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of the M3 Motorway, on a length of the A316 Trunk Road and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M25 Motorway, the M3 Motorway and the A316 Trunk Road (Thorpe Interchange and Sunbury Cross) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 19th May 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the M25”, “the M3” and “the A316” mean, respectively, the M25 Motorway, the M3 Motorway and the A316 Trunk Road in the County of Surrey;

“a length of carriageway” means –

- (i) both carriageways of the M3 between the slip roads leading to Sunbury Cross roundabout at Junction 1 (A308/A316) and the slip roads leading from Sunbury Cross roundabout at that Junction (A308/A316), or
- (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A316/M3 between its junction with Park Road and the slip road leading from Sunbury Cross roundabout at Junction 1 (A308/A316);

“a slip road” means -

- (i) the road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A316 from Sunbury Cross roundabout (M3 Junction 1/A308), or
- (ii) the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A316 to Sunbury Cross roundabout (M3 Junction 1/A308), including the access from Hanworth Road;

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(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

“a link road” means any road leading from the anti-clockwise carriageway or the clockwise carriageway of the M25 at Junction 12 to the eastbound carriageway of the M3 at Junction 2 at Thorpe Interchange;

“the side road” means the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A316 at Sunbury Cross (Park Road);

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, profile planning, bridge joint repairs, road marking and road stud installation work on the M25, the M3 and the A316; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 21st May 2012 or on any subsequent day until 18th November 2013.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a length of carriageway, a slip road, a link road or the side road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
