The A12 Trunk Road (Rackhams Corner Roundabout Corton to Links Road Roundabout Gorleston, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 30th April 2012

 Coming into force
 7th May 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road ("the A12"), is satisfied that traffic on that road in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Rackhams Corner Roundabout Corton to Links Road Roundabout Gorleston, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 7th May 2012.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 14th May 2012 or on any subsequent day until carriageway resurfacing and road marking reinstatement works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A12 between its junctions with the B1375 Rackhams Corner Roundabout Corton and Links Road Roundabout Gorleston.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle
 - (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or for traffic officer purposes,
 - (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
 - (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
 - (d) proceeding to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, that length of the A12.
