## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A5 Trunk Road (Dordon to Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, between Dordon and Atherstone in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Dordon to Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 6th June 2012.

## **2.** In this Order:

"Dordon Roundabout"	means the roundabout junction of the A5 with Gypsy Lane and Long Street, Dordon;
"Grendon Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A5 at its junction with Boot Hill and Spon Lane;
"Holly Lane Roundabout"	means the roundabout junction of the A5 with the B4116 Merevale Lane and Holly Lane, near Atherstone;
"the trunk road"	means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A5 from Dordon Roundabout to Holly Lane Roundabout;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Wednesday 13th June 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or Grendon Roundabout.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
  - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works; or
  - (d) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
