**EDUCATION, ENGLAND**

**The Education (Student Fees, Awards and Support) (Amendment) Regulations 2012**

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1 and 2 of the Education (Fees and Awards) Act 1983<sup>(1)</sup>, sections 22 and 42(6) of the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998<sup>(2)</sup> and sections 24 and 47 of the Higher Education Act 2004<sup>(3)</sup>.
