ROAD TRAFFIC

The M3 Motorway (Junction 2, Westbound Carriageway) (No. 2) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - *8th October 2012*

Coming into force - - *1st November 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M3 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M3 Motorway (Junction 2, Westbound Carriageway) (No. 2) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st November 2012 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M3 Motorway in the County of Surrey;

“the length of westbound carriageway” means the westbound carriageway of the motorway between the link road leading to the clockwise and anti-clockwise carriageways of the M25 and the link road leading from the clockwise and anti-clockwise carriageways of the M25 at Junction 2 (M25 Junction 12);

“works” mean cyclic maintenance and/or urgent repair work on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Thursday 1st November 2012 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 2nd November 2012 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 3rd November 2012 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 4th November 2012 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until Thursday 31st October 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of westbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
