The Agriculture, Animals, Environment and Food etc. (Miscellaneous Amendments) Order 2012

The Secretary of State is designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 MI in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Union and medicinal products M2, measures in the veterinary and phytosanitary fields for the protection of public health M3, food (including drink) including the primary production of food M4, the environment M5 and the environmental aspects of product design M6.

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 M7 and sections 1 and 8(1) of the Animal Health Act 1981 M8.
