**LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND**

**The Cumbria (Electoral Changes) Order 2012**

*Made - - - - 17th December 2012*

*Coming into force in accordance with article 2*

Under section 58(4) of the Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009<sup>(1)</sup> (“the 2009 Act”) the Local Government Boundary Commission for England<sup>(2)</sup> published a report dated July 2012 stating its recommendations for changes to the electoral arrangements for the county of Cumbria.

A draft of the instrument has been laid before Parliament and a period of forty days has expired and neither House has resolved that the instrument be not made.

The Local Government Boundary Commission for England has decided to give effect to the recommendations for electoral changes and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 59(1) of the 2009 Act makes the following Order:
