## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A663 Trunk Road (Burnley Lane Subway, Chadderton) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A663 Trunk Road, is satisfied that pedestrians and cyclists using a subway forming part of that trunk road in the District of Oldham in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A663 Trunk Road (Burnley Lane Subway, Chadderton) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 30th March 2012.

**2.** In this Order;

"the trunk road" means the A663 Trunk Road;

"works" means parapet replacement and concrete repair works on the trunk road;

"the works period" means a period starting at 0000 hours on Saturday 31 March 2012 and ending at 2359 hours on Sunday 15 April 2012. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the subway" means the subway passing under the trunk road at Burnley Lane, Chadderton.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no pedestrian or cyclist shall enter or proceed in the subway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any person employed by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services who needs access for emergency purposes, any person engaged in the works, or traffic officers, or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
