ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1033 Trunk Road (Marfleet Roundabout to Somerden Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - *18th April 2013*

Coming into force - - *28th April 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1033 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Kingston upon Hull, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, lining, traffic loop reinstatement and routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1033 Trunk Road (Marfleet Roundabout to Somerden Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28th April 2013.

2. In this Order; -

“the A1033” means the A1033 Trunk Road;

“the eastbound carriageway” means the A1033 eastbound carriageway from its junction with Marfleet Avenue roundabout to its junction with Somerden Road Roundabout, a distance of 1535 metres;

“the westbound carriageway” means the A1033 westbound carriageways from its junction with Somerden Road Roundabout to its junction with Marfleet Avenue roundabout, a distance of 1530 metres;

“bus stop area” means any area of carriageway on a side of the A1033, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagrams 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 29th April 2013 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the eastbound carriageway or the westbound carriageway.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in a bus stop area situated adjacent to the A1033 eastbound carriageway or westbound carriageway between Marfleet Roundabout and Somerden Road Roundabout, a distance of 1535 metres.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A1033 at it junction with Marfleet Lane, Elba Street or Valletta Street.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A1033 to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
