

## SCHEDULE

Article 2(2)

### Particulars of the New Scheme

1. The nature and purposes of the New Scheme are to make grants to conserve existing parks and cemeteries so that local user groups have active involvement in their park or cemetery's management and which—
  - (a) make a lasting difference for heritage, people and communities; or
  - (b) are connected with health, education or the environment.
2. The New Scheme applies to England only.
3. The maximum amount of money which may be distributed under section 25(1) of the Act in any year under the New Scheme is £50 million.
4. The bodies participating in the New Scheme are the Big Lottery Fund and the National Heritage Memorial Fund.
5. The money to be distributed under section 25(1) of the Act under the New Scheme is attributable to each of the participating bodies in the following proportions—
  - (a) as to the Big Lottery Fund, 33.33 per cent; and
  - (b) as to the National Heritage Memorial Fund, 66.67 per cent.
6. The New Scheme will have effect from 1st June 2013 to 31st May 2025.
