



- (c) entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A5 at A421 Redmoor Interchange,
- (d) exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A5 at A421 Redmoor Interchange, and
- (e) entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A5 at A509 Portway Interchange;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(a); and in this definition “carriageway” means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, renewal of road markings and road studs, and drainage, verge and safety fence maintenance;

“the works period” means the period starting at 09.00 hours on Monday 5th August 2013 and ending when the works have been completed;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 24th July 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in –

- (a) the trunk road or a slip road, during a works period, or
- (b) any lay-by adjacent to the trunk road, during the works period.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority, or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
