**The Care Quality Commission (Membership) (Amendment)  
Regulations 2013**

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 3(4) of Schedule 1 to the Health and Social Care Act 2008(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Care Quality Commission (Membership) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 1st October 2013.

**Amendment to the Care Quality Commission (Membership) Regulations 2008**

2. In regulation 2 of the Care Quality Commission (Membership) Regulations 2008(b), for “not more than twelve” substitute “not more than fourteen”.
