ROAD TRAFFIC

The A14 Trunk Road (Bythorn to Godmanchester, Cambridgeshire) Lay-bys (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - 2nd September 2013

Coming into force - - 9th September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road ("the A14") is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Bythorn to Godmanchester, Cambridgeshire) Lay-bys (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 9th September 2013.

2. In this Order –

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**); and in this definition "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"works" mean principal inspections of Bythorn Accommodation, Barham Road, Ellington, Brampton Racecourse and Hinchingbrooke North and Hinchingbrooke South over-bridges;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 16th September 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter any lay-by adjacent to the A14 from the centre line of its southern junction with the B663 Toll Bar Lane at Junction 15 Bythorn Interchange to the centre point of Junction 24 Godmanchester Interchange.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from
time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in
connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer
purposes.
