**The Electricity and Gas Appeals
(Designation and Exclusion) Order 2013**

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the Act” means the Energy Act 2004;

“Change Board” has the same meaning as in section A1 of the Smart Energy Code;

“Panel” has the same meaning as in section A1 of the Smart Energy Code;

“Path 1 Modification” has the same meaning as in section A1 of the Smart Energy Code;

“Path 2 Modification” has the same meaning as in section A1 of the Smart Energy Code;

“Path 3 Modification” has the same meaning as in section A1 of the Smart Energy Code;

“Smart Energy Code” means the document of that title required to be maintained and in force pursuant to condition 21 of the smart meter communication licences⁽¹⁾; and

“smart meter communication licences” means—

- (a) the licence granted to Smart DCC Limited⁽²⁾ on 20th September 2013 under section 7AB⁽³⁾ of the Gas Act 1986⁽³⁾; and
- (b) the licence granted to Smart DCC Limited on 20th September 2013 under section 6(1A) of the Electricity Act 1989⁽⁴⁾.
