**MARINE POLLUTION**

**The Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution)  
(Limits) (Revocation) Regulations 2013**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Article 2 of the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution)(Law of the Sea Convention) Order 1996<sup>(1)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, makes the following Regulations.

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution) (Limits) (Revocation) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 31st March 2014.

**2.** The Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution) (Limits) Regulations 1996<sup>(2)</sup> and the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution) (Limits) Regulations 1997<sup>(3)</sup> are revoked.
