MARINE POLLUTION

The Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution) (Limits) (Revocation) Regulations 2013

Made 3rd December 2013 Laid before Parliament 18th December 2013 Coming into force -31st March 2014

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Article 2 of the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution)(Law of the Sea Convention) Order 1996(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, makes the following Regulations.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution) (Limits) (Revocation) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 31st March 2014.
- 2. The Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution) (Limits) Regulations 1996(b) and the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution) (Limits) Regulations 1997(c) are revoked.
