**The Crime and Courts Act 2013 (Commencement No. 7
and Saving and Consequential Provisions) Order 2013**

Saving provision

- 3.—(1) Section 24 of the Act has no effect in relation to an appeal if—
- (a) the date of the decision which is the subject of the appeal is before 7th January 2014; and
 - (b) the appellant serves notice on the Clerk to the Visitors of the Inns of Court in accordance with rule 4(1) of the Hearings before the Visitors Rules 2010⁽¹⁾ before 18th April 2014.
- (2) In this article, the “date of the decision” means—
- (a) in a case where there is an oral hearing, the date on which the decision is announced at that hearing, whether or not the appellant is present at the announcement; or
 - (b) in a case where there is no oral hearing, the date of the written notice of the outcome of the appeal.
