The Legal Aid, Sentencing and Punishment of Offenders Act 2012 (Commencement No. 5 and Saving Provision) Order 2013

## Provisions coming into force on 19th January 2013

**2.**—(1) Subject to article 4, the following provisions of the 2012 Act come into force on 19th January 2013 for the purpose only of exercising any power to make orders, regulations or rules of court—

- (a) section 44 (conditional fee agreements: success fees)(1);
- (b) section 45 (damages-based agreements)(2), in so far as it is not already in force for that purpose; and
- (c) section 46 (recovery of insurance premiums).

(2) Section 48 (sections 44 and 46 and diffuse mesothelioma proceedings) of the 2012 Act comes into force on 19th January 2013.
