The Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 (Amendment) Order 2014

Made - - - - 27th May 2014

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001(1).

A draft of this Order was laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament in accordance with section 10A(3)(2) of that Act.

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 (Amendment) Order 2014.
 - (2) This Order shall come into force on the twenty eighth day after the day it is made.

Amendment of section 1(1) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001

2. In the Table in section 1(1) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001(3), after the entry relating to section 5(2) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971(4) insert—

"Section 5(2) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 so far as relating to the followingPossession of khat or any preparation or other product containing khat"

(a) khat (within the meaning given by Part 4 of Schedule 2 to that Act), or
