**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A500 Trunk Road (A53 Etruria Road, Stoke-on-Trent)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - 20th January 2014

*Coming into force* - - 27th January 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road (“the A500”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that trunk road at Stoke-on-Trent in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (A53 Etruria Road, Stoke-on-Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th January 2014.

2. In this Order:

- “the roundabout”                      means –
- (i) the northern section of the circulatory carriageway at the roundabout junction of the A500 with the A53 Etruria Road from its junction with the slip leading to the northbound carriageway of the A500, to its junction with the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of A500; and
  
  - (ii) the southern section of the circulatory carriageway at the roundabout junction of the A500 with the A53 Etruria Road from its junction with the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A500, to its junction with the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A500;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 3rd February 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the roundabout.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
