**The M271 Motorway (Junction 1 – Redbridge Roundabout)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - - *28th July 2014*
Coming into force - - - - - *16th August 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M271 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of the M271 and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M271 Motorway (Junction 1 – Redbridge Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 16th August 2014.

2. In this Order:

“M271” means the M271 Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

“the length of carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the motorway between the tip of the nosing of the ‘off’ slip road at Junction 1 and Redbridge Roundabout (A33);

“the slip road” means the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 1;

“works” means essential carriageway repairs and all associated works including, but not limited to, resurfacing, drainage improvements, vegetation clearance, bridge inspections, reinstatement of road markings and studs; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 23rd August 2014 or any subsequent day until 15th February 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 below, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road or the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (a) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
