ROAD TRAFFIC

The M66 Motorway (Junction 18 Southbound Dedicated Link Road to the M62 Eastbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *14th August 2014*

Coming into force - - *20th August 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M66 Motorway and its link roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the Borough of Bury in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M66 Motorway (Junction 18 Southbound Dedicated Link Road to the M62 Eastbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 20th August 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M66 Motorway;

“the dedicated link road” means the dedicated link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 18 to the eastbound carriageway of the M62 Motorway;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2000 hours and 0600 hours during a period starting on Thursday 21 August 2014 and ending on Wednesday 23 December 2015. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such further period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means barrier works.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the dedicated link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance works or by traffic officers, or for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
