**The Tuberculosis (Deer and Camelid) (England) Order 2014**

**PART 2**

**Deer**

**Notification of suspected tuberculosis in a deer carcass**

**4.—**(1) A person in possession or charge of a deer carcass, or a veterinary surgeon who examines any such carcass, who suspects that the carcass may be affected with tuberculosis must give immediate notice of such suspicion to the Secretary of State.

(2) Following such notification the carcass must be detained on the premises on which it was located at the time when notification was given, and isolated as far as practicable from other deer and livestock prior to a veterinary inquiry taking place under article 5 or a diagnostic sample being taken from the carcass under the direction of a veterinary inspector.

(3) If the carcass is in a slaughterhouse the operator of the slaughterhouse must keep it isolated from other carcasses of slaughtered animals.
