**2014 No. 2706**

**The International Criminal Court Act 2001 (Jersey) Order 2014**

**2.** The following provisions of the International Criminal Court Act 2001 shall extend to the Bailiwick of Jersey—

- (a) section 23(5) (extension of powers under United Nations Act 1946<sup>(1)</sup>);
- (b) sections 44 and 45 (transfer of prisoner);
- (c) section 70 (amendment of Geneva Conventions Act 1957<sup>(2)</sup>); and
- (d) section 83 and Schedule 10 (repeals)<sup>(3)</sup>, so far as they relate to the Geneva Conventions Act 1957, the Genocide Act 1969<sup>(4)</sup> and the Geneva Conventions (Amendment) Act 1995<sup>(5)</sup>;

subject to the modifications set out in the Schedule to this Order.
