**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A50 Trunk Road (Longton, Stoke-On-Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2014**

*Made - - - - 17th November 2014*

*Coming into force - 24th November 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Longton in the City of Stoke-on-Trent, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Longton, Stoke-On-Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 24th November 2014.

2. In this Order:

“Foley Road Interchange” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A50, Baths Road and Foley Road;

“Trentham Road Interchange” means the circulatory carriageways of the dumbbell roundabout junction of the A50, A5035 Trentham Road, A5007 The Strand/Commerce Street and Normacot Road;

“the trunk road” means the –  
a) eastbound carriageway of the A50 from the junction with the slip road leading to Foley Road interchange, to the junction with the slip road leading from Trentham Road Interchange; and  
b) westbound carriageway of the M50 from the junction with the slip road leading to Trentham Road Interchange, to the junction with the slip road leading from Foley Road Interchange;

“the works period” means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 1st December and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
