 - (3) In paragraph (1) after the word "requested", insert "in any other year".
 - (4) For paragraph (2) substitute—
 - "(2) The amount required to be paid for each allowance at a special allocation—

They correct an error and set the price of allowances issued in relation to 2014 at £12, which is the intended policy.
