## Consequential Amendments to Primary Legislation

## Marriage Act 1949

- **5.**—(1) The Marriage Act 1949(1) is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 28(2) (declaration to accompany notice of marriage), in subsection (1)(c), for "or widow" substitute ", widow or surviving civil partner".
  - (3) After section 42(3)(3) (cancellation of registration of building) insert—
    - "(3A) In a case where—
      - (a) the registration of a building is cancelled under this section, and
      - (b) the building is also registered under section 43A,

the Registrar General must also cancel the registration under section 43A.".

- (4) In section 49A(4) (which provides marriages of same sex couples may be void in the absence of the required consent), in subsection (2), after paragraph (b) insert—
  - "(ba) section 26A(3) and under any regulations made under section 44C that require the consent to use of a building for the solemnization of marriages of same sex couples, in a case where section 26A and section 44C apply to the marriage;".
