ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1033 Trunk Road (Craven Street South to Salt End Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - 20th February 2014

Coming into force - 2nd March 2014

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1033 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Kingston Upon Hull, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because cyclic routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A1033 Trunk Road (Craven Street South to Salt End Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2014.

2. In this Order: -

“the A1033” means the A1033 Trunk Road;

“the cycle track” means a way constituting or comprised in a highway, being a way over which the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on pedal cycles (other than pedal cycles which are motor vehicles within the meaning of the Road Traffic Act 1988) with or without a right of way on foot;

“footway” means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot only;

“the works period” means a period of 14 hours starting at 06:00 hours on Monday 3rd March 2014 or any subsequent day thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, enter or proceed in sections of the footway adjacent to the A1033 eastbound carriageway between Craven Street South and Salt End Roundabout, a distance of approximately 5100 metres.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, enter or proceed in sections of the cycle track adjacent to the A1033 eastbound carriageway between Craven Street South and Salt End Roundabout, a distance of approximately 5100 metres.

5. The provisions of articles 3, and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

nothing in articles 3 and 4 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A1033 to or from premises and property which is accessible for that person from, and only from, that road;

and nothing in articles 3 and 4 shall apply to any person engaged or assisting in the said works, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
