The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3(2) of the HGV Road User Levy Act 2013(a).

## Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the HGV Road User Levy (Exemption of Specified Roads) Order 2014 and comes into force on $1^{\text {st }}$ April 2014.

## Exemption of Specified Roads

2. The HGV Road User Levy Act 2013 does not apply to the roads specified in the Schedule.
