The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Dunsfold) Regulations 2015

Made -	-	-	-	14th April 2015
Coming into	force	-	-	29th August 2015

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Dunsfold, Surrey, by reason of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 29th and 30th August 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2009(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Dunsfold) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 29th August 2015.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) the times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(**b**).

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) between 1030 hours and 1730 hours on 29th and 30th August 2015 no aircraft is to fly—

- (a) below 2,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by—
 - (i) an anticlockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 12 nautical miles whose centre is at 510853N 0001125W, from 510949N 0003025W to 510440N 0002914W, and
 - (ii) a clockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 3 nautical miles whose centre is at 510702N 0003209W, from 510440N 0002914W to 510949N 0003025W; or
- (b) below 1,500 feet above mean sea level within the elliptical area bounded by-
 - (i) a clockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 3 nautical miles whose centre is at 510702N 0003209W, from 510949N 0003025W to 510440N 0002914W, and
 - (ii) a clockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 12 nautical miles whose centre is at 510853N 0001125W, from 510440N 0002914W to 510949N 0003025W.

⁽b) In these Regulations Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the Dunsfold air show flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Dunsfold, Surrey, on the occasion of an air show that will be held on 29th and 30th August 2015. A large number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. Accordingly, the Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the displays for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2), the Dunsfold air show flying display director may be contacted on telephone number 07711 437499.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
