ROAD TRAFFIC

The A550 Trunk Road (Welsh Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A550 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on a section of that trunk road in Cheshire West and Chester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the A550 Trunk Road (Welsh Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 1st March 2015.

2. In this Order;

"the trunk road" means the A550 Trunk Road;

"works" means survey works;

"the works period" means periods overnight between 2000 hours and 0700 hours (ending at 0500 hours on weekday mornings) during a period starting on Monday 2nd March 2015 and ending on Saturday 7th March 2015. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the length of carriageway" means the northbound and southbound dual, and single carriageway sections of the trunk road from the point where the A550 diverges to join the A494 to the point where the A41 joins the A550, a distance of 7740 metres.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, for winter maintenance purposes or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
