ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Little Eaton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015

Made - - - - 9th March 2015

Coming into force - - 16th March 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and on one of those connecting roads, in the City of Derby and the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Little Eaton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Monday 16th March 2015.

2. In this Order –

| “Palm Court Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A6, Kings Croft and the slip roads leading to and from the A38; |
| “Little Eaton Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A38, A6179 Alfreton Road and Ford Lane; |
| “the trunk road” | means the northbound carriageway of the A38 from the junction with the slip road leading to Palm Court Roundabout for a distance of 1.93 kilometres in a north easterly direction, including the northern section of the circulatory carriageway of Little Eaton Roundabout; |
| “the slip road” | means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A38 from Palm Court Roundabout; |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 23rd March 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at the junction with Ford Lane, 180 metres east of the River Derwent bridge.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works.
