The Justification Decision (Generation of Electricity by the UK ABWR Nuclear Reactor) Regulations 2015

Justification decision

3. For the purposes of Article 6(1) of the 1996 Directive, subject to regulation 4, the following are justified—

- (a) the UK ABWR practice(1); and
- (b) any class or type of practice which is—
 - (i) a development of the UK ABWR practice; and
 - (ii) so similar to the UK ABWR practice that the balance of benefits and detriments from that class or type of practice does not materially differ from the balance of benefits and detriments from the UK ABWR practice(**2**).
