PART 3

Retention and return of seized property

Claim period

10. A person may make a claim of entitlement to seized property, accompanied by the evidence required by regulation 11, within the period—

- (a) beginning with the date of seizure; and
- (b) ending 15 working days after the date of the seizure notice.
