The Environment and Rural Affairs (Miscellaneous Revocations) Regulations 2015

The Secretary of State is designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(1) in relation to the common agricultural policy(2) and the environment(3).

The Secretary of State has consulted Natural England and the Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission for England in accordance with section 99 of the Environment Act 1995(4).

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972, paragraph 8 of Schedule 2 to the Water Act 1983(5) and, with the consent of the Treasury, section 56(1) and (2) of the Finance Act 1973(6).

Citation, commencement and application

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Environment and Rural Affairs (Miscellaneous Revocations) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 1st April 2015.
 - (2) Regulations 2 to 4 apply to England.
